**6. MOTION - URGING THE GOVERNOR TO UNDERTAKE A COMPLETE OVERHAUL OF THE COUNTY TREASURY AND THE FINANCE DEPARTMENT AT LARGE AND RECRUIT COMPETENT PERSONS TO RUN THE SAID OFFICES**

**THAT**, aware that the Nairobi City County Treasury and Finance Department at large recently suffered bad publicity thanks to the suspension of senior officials for alleged mega corruption; deeply concerned that despite Audit reports uncovering the looting of millions in unreported revenues by corrupt officials within the Cash Office not much has been done to reform and streamline the Department; noting for instance that an Auditor General's report on Nairobi County Government revenue records for the FY 2012/2013 revealed that during the period 1<sup>st</sup> January 2013 to 30 June 2013, a total of Ksh.5,511,732,231 was collected from the various sources of revenue but only Ksh.5,258,849,088 was banked reflecting under-banking of Kshs.252,883,143, for which no one was held accountable; convinced that not much has changed as officers within the County Treasury and especially at the revenue cash collections Office continue to operate business as usual, as evidenced by the recent suspension of senior officers for alleged graft; this Assembly resolves that the Governor undertakes a complete overhaul of the County Treasury and the Finance Department at large and recruit competent persons to run the said

Offices in order to stem the rot and looting of revenues that would otherwise go a long way in building a better City for Nairobi residents.
