### 4. MOTION - ESTABLISHMENT OF THE LIAISON OFFICE

*Motion made and question proposed: –* 

**THAT,** aware that Article 174 of the Constitution of Kenya 2010 states that one of the objects of devolution is to promote social and economic development and the provision of proximate, easily accessible services throughout the Country, enhance checks and balances and the separation of powers; further aware that Article 185 (3) of the Constitution states that a County Assembly while respecting the

principle of the separation of powers, may exercise oversight over the County Executive Committee and any other County Executive organs; concerned that the County Assembly has experienced challenges in getting vital information from the County Executive on different matters such as implementation of various proposed projects, motions; noting that most of the County projects in various Wards have stalled thus hindering efficient service delivery to Nairobi City County residents; this Assembly urges the County Executive to establish a County Liaison Office that will act as a centre of information between the County Legislature and the Executive in the implementation of the County Assembly resolutions.
